











## Set administrator password

For security purposes, we recommend you change the administrator password. When you connect the WIFI-1 to your display network, follow the prompts on your display unit to change the administrator password. Remember to note the new password.

**Note:** After changing the password, the WIFI-1 will restart and will be offline for about 30 seconds.

#### WIFI-1 modes

The WIFI-1 can be operated in one of two modes:

### **Connecting your phone/tablet mode**

Use the wireless settings dialog to connect mobile devices to the MFD via the WIFI-1. Use the Navico®/brand mobile app on the mobile device to access the vessel's navigation information. For more information about the Navico®/brand mobile app, refer to the MFD documentation.



#### **Accessing the Internet mode**

In the MFD, use the **Connect to the Internet** option in the wireless settings dialog to access the internet via the WIFI-1.

**Note:** While accessing the Internet, mobile devices can no longer access the MFD navigation information unless there is a second WIFI-1 connected to the system, or the unit has a built-in WIFI module.
